Y6 SATS tests

The children have worked tremendously hard over the whole year and it is an opportunity for them to show what they can achieve.

Y2 SATs

Currently there is a consultation from the government about ending the tests used in Year 2, possibly even from next year. The 'tests' for this year group are actually very low key and a supportive measure for our own assessment of the pupils. We have always taken a relaxed approach to the tests and have made them a positive experience for the children, you would be amazed at how many enjoy the structure and the approach taken by us. These will take place throughout May, at a time when best suits the children and the school. It would help us greatly, however, if the children are in school on time.
