

School Update 10

Dear Parents/Carers

Phased Re-opening of Pilsley Primary will not be happening on the 1st June.

Further to our earlier letters in May and the directive from Government to begin planning for a phased reopening of schools beyond the current childcare provision from 1st June, we have now received notice from the Local Authority (Derbyshire County Council) that says the DFE guidance to schools lacks clarity and therefore we have taken the decision, along with all primary schools in the Five Pits cluster, to delay the phased return plans until a later date.

Therefore, we will definitely **only be open on the 1**st **June for Key/Critical Worker childcare** whilst Derbyshire seeks further precision in government advice.

Clearly, as a staff team we had finalised our plans and were looking forward to seeing more children in school after the Spring Bank holiday. However this instruction comes as the Local Authority feels that a delay to reopening would **allow us all to have more certainty about the safety of our school community.**

We have also received an indication that Derbyshire are asking us to review all plans for the phased opening of schools with an initial focus on those of us who have chosen not to open nursery's first.

We also understand that the government may well be making announcements very soon with regard to the guidance around nursery pupils in schools. Our initial decision not to open nursery was based on this lack of clarity and support.

Therefore, please do not assume that the plan the school had in place for each year group will remain the same. We will be in touch as soon as we can and if we alter the proposed plan we will send out a new survey to gauge numbers. Clearly, a delay in opening may also lead to you changing your original decision as infection rates hopefully drop nationally.

We know that this may well affect many of your plans for returning to work and the frustration and difficulties this brings. You have our assurances that we will continue to make all our preparations, including the changes to our school environment and detailed risk assessments, so that when we get further clarity and precision in the guidance to begin our phased reopening, we will have minimised all potential risk factors.
