We have a real concern over the use of the Public Footpath through the school field over the last few weeks. We are seeing a huge increase in the amount of **DOG MESS** that has been found on the school field. This is not only happening after school or before school but is also happening during school time. However, we would greatly appreciate <u>that if you know anyone</u> who does use our school field to walk their dogs if you would remind them:

- not to let their dogs foul our children's play space
- that they should ensure the dogs are always on the lead.
